The Association of Inhalation Toxicologists (AIT) conference will take place on **Tuesday 3rd to Thursday 5th June 2025** at the Kents Hill Park Conference Centre in Milton Keynes, UK. There will also be an opportunity to attend an optional visit to ImmuONE Laboratories in Stevenage, UK (which includes a practical inhalation session hosted by Labcorp) on Monday 2nd June 2025 (limited to 50 people, first registered take priority; email with your expression of interest at attend as you register for the conference; spaces are allocated first come first served).

Attending this conference will commence/renew your AIT membership for the next 3 years and allow free access during your membership to the secure members area of the AIT website to view the recorded webinars and PDF presentations held there from the previous year.

It is recommended that you book as a Delegate as early as possible and then use the hotel booking link provided to secure your room at the Kents Hill Park Conference Centre at the discounted AIT Group Booking rate. The ImmuONE visit may require an additional night in the hotel if you are not local (see the hotel details later).

The conference hotel is part of the Kents Hill Park Conference site. Please see below the booking link for guests to book bedrooms. **The reduced rate is available from Saturday 31st May up to and including Friday 6th June.** Guests just need to navigate to the dates they want and then book from there. **If you need additional night's,** you can book these at the same time but please remove the promo code for the additional nights and then you can stay in the same room.

Included in the B&B room rates quoted is use of the onsite Nuffield Fitness Centre (age 16 and above). The swimming pool, spa pool, steam room, sauna and gym may be used free of charge. The sports hall is available for hire (five-a-side football, volleyball and badminton etc) and the fitness classes can be booked but will have an additional charge.

Discounted rooms will all be released gradually from 6 weeks prior to the event so please ensure you book your room early otherwise you may be charged at a higher rate (£90/night B&B single occupancy; £100/night B&B double occupancy; dinner can be booked and paid for at the venue once you are checked in, approximately £10/person).

Driving to Kents Hill Park: Free parking for 450 vehicles.

From the South- Exit the M1 at Junction 13 and follow the A421 towards Milton Keynes. Continue for two miles until you reach the Kingston roundabout. Take the third exit onto Standing Way (H8) and continue straight over the next roundabout (Brinklow). At the next roundabout (Kents Hill) turn left onto Brickhill Street (V10). Take first turning on the left at the mini roundabout. Turn left again at the T junction and then take the next right to the Training & Conference Centre. Swallow Reception is the building with the clock tower.

From the North- Exit the M1 at junction 14 and turn right towards Milton Keynes. At the first roundabout (Northfield) go straight over and at the second roundabout (FoxMilne) turn left (first exit) onto Tongwell Street (V11). Follow this road and at the second roundabout (Brinklow) turn right (third exit) onto Standing Way (H8). Continue to the next roundabout (Kents Hill) and turn left (first exit) onto Brickhill Street (V10). Take first turning on the left at the mini roundabout and turn left at the T junction. Take the first right and Swallow Reception is in the building with the clock tower.

From the West - From Buckingham, take the A421 towards Milton Keynes. This road becomes Standing Way (H8). Continue along Standing Way until the roundabout at Brickhill Street (V10), Kents Hill. Turn right (third exit) onto Brickhill Street. Take first turning on the left at the mini roundabout and turn left at the T junction. Take the first right and Swallow Reception is the building with the clock tower.

Parking

Please note Kents Hill car park is managed by Parking Eye. On arrival please ensure that you enter your car registration for your entire stay at either the main reception or in Nightingale House. Failure to do so will result in a parking charge from parking eye. Please speak to the reception staff in case the process has changed.

Nearest: London Luton: 22.6 miles

- Hire car (with satnav) or via Taxi/Uber: approximately 33 minutes via the M1 motorway.
- Public transport (bus): (bus recommended for most direct journeys with no changes and from £12 GBP single journey ticket); takes approx 45 minutes; National express direct to Milton Keynes Coachway M1, Junction 14. Then Taxi the last 4 miles.

London Heathrow: 54.4 miles

- Hire car (with satnav) or via Taxi/Uber: approximately 1 hour 15 minutes via the M25 and M1 motorways.
- Public transport (bus recommended for most direct journeys with no changes and from £18 GBP single journey) approx 1 hour 50 minutes: National express direct to Milton Keynes Coachway M1, Junction 14. Then Taxi the last 4 miles.
- Ticket info: (enter search as London Heathrow to Milton Keynes Coachway M1 Junction 14)

- Public transport (train several changes): approx 2.5 hours.
 - Elizabeth line to Tottenham Court Road, change to the Northern line to Warren Street, Walk 2 minutes to Euston Station. There are direct trains from Euston to Milton Keynes Railway station.
 - Kents Hill Park Training and Conference Centre is about four miles from Central Milton Keynes railway station. MK Central is a high speed train stop; trains are frequent and journey times from London Euston station vary between 35 and 60 minutes.

London Gatwick: 67 miles

- Public transport (bus recommended for most direct journeys with no changes and from £20 GBP single journey) approx 3 to 4 hours: National express direct to Milton Keynes Coachway M1, Junction 14. Then Taxi the last 4 miles.

The train from Gatwick to Euston Station, then on to MK Central station takes around 2.5 hours with several changes.
